THE GREAT UPSTATE SNOW GAMES - RULES & EXPECTATIONS

Our goal at Rhino Lacrosse is to provide a safe and comfortable environment for all attendees while adhering to the recommended CDC and county guidelines. Participants and spectators will witness a different event experience than previous years, but it comes with the best intentions of overall personal safety and looking forward to a return to normalcy. Below you will find the steps Rhino Lacrosse has implemented for all events.

IF YOU ARE FEELING SICK OR HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO A COVID-19 POSITIVE PERSON WITHIN THE PAST 14 DAYS, PLEASE STAY HOME!

RHINO LACROSSE STAFF:

- All staff members will have their temperatures taken upon arrival in the morning before the start of the event
- All staff members are required to wear a mask/face-covering throughout the duration of the event
- They are provided with adequate accessibility to hand sanitizer and antibacterial wipes for regular usage

PARTICIPANTS/SPECTATORS:

- ALL PLAYERS, PARENTS, ETC. MUST WEAR A MASK THE ENTIRITY OF THE EVENT, THIS IS INCLUDING PLAYERS WHILE PLAYING!
- **PLEASE** Stay home if you are not feeling well, are experiencing a fever, cough, body aches, other COVID symptoms, or have been exposed to the virus.
- We highly encourage anyone who is at a higher risk or with underlying health issues to please stay home.
- Any and all attendees who are displaying COVID-19 symptoms will be immediately asked to leave the event.
- Due to the size of the event, we ask that only ONE (1) adult per team be in attendance for the check-in if needed and then return to their cars once games begin (NO SPECTATORS). We must limit the amount of foot traffic and number of people on site at one time. Again, only if necessary is one adult per team is allowed at check-in, and we ask others to remain in their vehicles.
- We ask that all attendees practice social distancing measures to the best of their ability.
- All players who are not in the midst of game play must adhere to the 6ft social distancing rules on the sidelines, and remain outside the snow fencing in between games.

ON-SITE PRECAUTIONS:

- Players are asked to stand 6ft apart on the sidelines, and a reminder that no coaches/parents are allowed on the benches/sidelines.
- Only one representative per team will be allowed at the check-in table. We ask that you discuss this with your team prior to arrival to avoid any confusion and lines forming. We suggest designating a place for team members and their adult representative to meet onsite.
- There will be no access to restrooms.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the venue for player and spectator use.
- There will be no pre or post-game handshakes, cheers, celebrations, etc. to avoid unnecessary physical contact among individuals.
- Players will be asked to leave immediately following the completion of their games.
- To the best of our ability, we will attempt to schedule teams to have no longer than a 15–30-minute time period between games. Congregating on sidelines will not be permitted at any time. Please be mindful of this rule and keep 6 feet apart at all times when not playing.
- Each parent/guardian, athlete, coach, manager, referee/official must sign an agreement that a condition of ongoing participation includes full cooperation with case investigations and contact elicitation and adherence to isolation and quarantine orders.

We look forward to being back on the field and restoring a small sense of normalcy one step at a time. We are determined to provide a safe environment while respecting the current guidelines and circumstances. We kindly ask that all players, spectators, families and staff adhere to the guidelines so we can continue to move forward and get back to playing the game we all love.
